1. System requirements

Required: A computer with a CD-ROM drive and PDF reader software (eg, Adobe Acrobat Reader).

Note: This CD-ROM contains PDF files and you will need suitable software to view them. Macintosh and Unix users should have this as standard. Windows users may need to install a reader such as Adobe Acrobat Reader – two versions are included on this CD:

- a) Adobe Acrobat Reader v7 – the current version at time of issue, recommended for more recent computers running Windows 2000/XP;
- b) Adobe Acrobat Reader v4 – an older version which may be more suitable if you have an older less powerful computer.
